6. I will shake hands with the other team and officials after games.
7. Practice attendance is imperative! Missing practice will effect playing time and your standing on the team.
8. Playing time will not be equal. Every minute must be earned beginning on the defensive end.
9. Constant communication with coaches and Club1 / Always 100 leadership is crucial in your growth. Your parents may not fights your battles, if you have made the choice to play basketball. Players please discuss
10. Any technical foul or bad body language the player will be suspended for 1 game (Dependent on coaches).
11. Coaches need a 24 hour notice if you are not able to make it to practice or a tournament.

4. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect at all times regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.
5. I will never ridicule my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
6. I will respect the officials and coaches for their authority during games and practices; I will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the gymnasium, but will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed-upon
7. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the registered coaches for the team.

Club Team Commitment

Any player that elects to not participate once they have committed to play for Club1 / Always 100, refund eligibility is based on the total season fee cost:

- Written Notification to the Club1 Director prior to October 1st: 50 %
- Written Notification to the Club1 Director after October 1st: No Refund

Injury Policy

Any player that suffers an injury that is medically proven to prohibit them from participating in practice and competition with their Club1 / Always 100 team for the duration of the current season, may be eligible for the following refund of the total season fee schedule. Participants requesting a refund will need to provide a doctor's slip that explains the nature of the injury. Funds will be returned by December 1st of the current club season.

- Written Notification to the Club1 Director prior to October 1st: 80 %
- Written Notification to the Club1 Director prior to November 1st: 50 %
- Written Notification to the Club1 Director prior to December 1st: 30 %
- Written Notification to the Club1 Director after December 1st: No Refund
